Description/Brief:

ECCI is one of the University of Edinburgh's impact and innovation centres, with a successful track record in supporting low carbon businesses and providing expertise to aid the development of new low carbon products and services.

ECCI has partnered with Climate-KIC, the largest climate entrepreneurship network in Europe to provide support to low carbon start-ups. ECCI will run the Accelerator (Stage 1) programme from July 2020 to August 2020 - the programme provides a hands-on support model with training and skills workshops, mentoring with experts, funding, industry advice and contacts in the low carbon sector.

ECCI require consultants with experience of working with developing and commercial stage businesses, entrepreneurs and climate change stakeholders to support and widen ECCI's current low carbon innovation work. This tender is specifically for providing:

A two hour '*interactive*' online workshop on how to pitch effectively at award competitions and to investors, communicating the business product and/or service and covering key criteria (e.g., pricing, USP, beachhead market, IP) on 27 July 2020 from 10.00 - 12.00 (exact time tbc).
