## Quick Wins

- Train drivers on smart/eco/fuel efficient driving techniques
- Consider installing adaptive cruise control for long-distance fleet vehicles to improve fuel economy
- Optimise vehicle routes
- Perform regular vehicle maintenance to ensure efficient running conditions
- Apply for the EST's free-of-charge fleet review to identify opportunities to reduce emissions, fuel costs, and expenditure
- Implement a low emissions requirements for owned and leased company cars.

## Core Actions

- Switch company vehicles to EVs
- Enable last mile deliveries by low-carbon electric modes of transport and trial cargo bikes/e-cargo bikes.
- Trial consolidation hubs for freight
- Optimise vehicle size for cargo deliveries
- Maintain, repair, and/or upgrade poor energy performance equipment

## Transformative Actions

- Collaborate to enable key climate-enabling technologies and share best known examples and methodologies.
- Influence local and national policymakers to step up climate action and policies in line with a 1.5°C ambition.
- Advocate for regulatory bodies to promote industry-wide action.
- Brainstorm with colleagues around the potential threats and opportunities from climate change (for example by using UKCIP's BACLIAT tool, [www.ukciporg.uk/bacliat](http://www.ukciporg.uk/bacliat)).
- Think about the products and services that society will need more of as the climate changes and consider during your strategic planning whether your company is in a position to exploit any of these markets. Obtain first mover advantage by trying out or developing new products, processes, technologies or ways of working.
